# Negative examples of how to use pictures

In this example, clip arts are used, which looks just amateurish. Besides, the pictures are not aligned and have different sizes

#### School in 1990

- In 1990, the "wisdom of the world" was to be found in books only
- That's why pupils used to carry around large amount of books in their satchels
- Severe back problems were often the result



### School in 2013

- In 2013, almost anything can be found online (e.g. Wikipedia)
- That's why pupils don't have to carry such heavy loads anymore
- The number of pupils under the age of 12 with back problems has decreased significantly over the last 10 years



# Negative examples of how to use pictures

Much better, since the pictures effectively underline the messages of the text and look "almost" professional.

However, the look of the pictures is inconsistent (photograph combined with graphics) and the pictures are squeezed too much in the lower right corner of the text fields



# Positive examples of how to use pictures

In this example, the pictures very effectively support and actually *transport* the messages in the text fields

#### **Analysis**

- Workshops with the top management level to identify critical sub-projects with a high degree of complexity and dependencies
- Deep-dive into the identified critical sub-projects to assess the scope of the change and the consequences for affected organization units



#### **Action**

- Decide on an action-plan that describes in detail the ten most important activities per sub-project


